Thank you for being a part of Kick-A-Palooza 11, hosted by the Kickball League of Hampton Roads at the Virginia Beach KOA!

Planning Ahead

Your team needs to wear some form of matching or similar attire so that our umpires can tell you apart from your competitors. There are no official jerseys for this event. Feel free to be creative. (The shirt that you receive at check-in is intended to be a souvenir shirt from this special event. Everyone receives the same color shirt.)

The following food and beverages will be served in the KOA Pavilion and are complimentary with your event registration.

- **Friday 7:00 – 9:00 PM:** Hot dogs and s'mores with skewers for roasting over the communal bonfire, plus draft beer from Cape Charles Brewing, hard seltzer from Afterglow Brewing, and domestic beer
- **Saturday 6:30 – 8:00 PM:** Burgers, brats, potato salad, macaroni and cheese, chips, cookies, water, craft beer provided by Cape Charles Brewing, and craft hard seltzer provided by Afterglow Brewing (plus a domestic beer keg)
Competitive teams will each receive one complimentary set of cocktails (exact product dependent on availability)

Please arrange for your own food at breakfast and lunch. Worst case scenario? Pizza delivery!

Firewood is **not** provided. Any firewood at the KOA Pavilion is for the communal bonfire only. Please plan ahead and bring or purchase your own firewood for any fires at your personal campsite or cabin.

Arrival

All vehicles should enter the KOA from General Booth Blvd. KOA parking attendants will be directing traffic on Saturday morning. All players must check-in at the pavilion on Friday night between 7:00pm and 9:00pm or on Saturday morning before 8:30am. We are expecting our largest turnout ever this year – plan to arrive early to avoid delays and missing any of your valuable game time!

If you have guests with your group that wish to participate in the weekend event festivities, specifically the parties, please ensure that they have registered as official event guests (\$20 fee in advance, \$30 at the event) through our website with a credit card or in person with cash. Thank you!

A friendly reminder that there is an additional **\$5 per person cash fee** at the KOA gate on Saturday for any player and spectator *not* already camping at the KOA. This fee entitles you to full use of the campground and most of its amenities for the day, including restrooms, showers, and parking (pool is separate, additional fee). 100% of the proceeds from this gate fees goes to support Care Camps, which provide a camp experience to children who are undergoing cancer treatment. For any players *not* staying at the KOA but still coming for the party on Friday night, you can park behind the KOA general store. If that small lot is full, please park in the grass lot just across Prosperity Road.

Kids and pets are both allowed at this event. Both must be friendly. KOA rules are that pets must be leashed. If your dog is deemed unruly, they may be required to leave the premises. If either your dog or your child is left unsupervised, you may be asked to leave the event.

Game Details

All games will be played according to the official rules of the Kickball League of Hampton Roads. Competitive teams will play using "A" level rules. Social teams will play using "B" level rules. Just-For-Fun teams will play using "C" level rules.

Group stage games can end in a tie. The home team for all group stage games is as listed in the schedule.

Seeding from each group for elimination rounds and placement games will be based on record, followed by head-to-head results. If two or more teams are still tied after that, we will use the KLOHR tournament tiebreaker:

One male and one female from each team will kick a stationary ball at home plate, with the ball coming to a rest closest to 2nd base being declared the winner.

The lower (better) seed will be the home team in all elimination rounds and placement games. If both teams are equally seeded, the home team will be the team with the better record. If both teams have the same record, the home team will be determined by coin flip.

Elimination round seeding for competitive teams will be announced between 12:50 PM and 1:35 PM after the results of the group stage are known. The top team from each group will receive the top three seeds, ranked by overall record. Likewise, the middle team from each group will receive the middle three seeds, and the last team from each group will receive the bottom three seeds, again being ranked by overall record.

Final games for fun teams will be announced between 1:35 PM and 2:30 PM after the results of the first three games are known.

Championship trophies, medals, and prizes will be presented on field immediately following the conclusion of those games.

Party Details

On Friday night, check in at the KOA Pavilion to get your event shirt, wristband, and other swag. Then party with us in the pavilion where event staff will be serving complimentary Cape Charles Brewing draft beer and Afterglow Brewing hard seltzer (plus domestic beer) to all registered participants and guests. We'll be playing cornhole, bucket pong, and other yard games and gathering around a communal campfire with s'mores and hot dogs. Feel free to bring your own additional munchies and libations. Come thirsty and ready to get this big weekend started off right!

On Saturday night, come cap off a long day in the KOA Pavilion with a dinner tailgate buffet featuring burgers, brats, potato salad, mac & cheese, chips, and cookies. Event staff will again be serving complimentary Cape Charles Brewing draft beer and Afterglow Brewing hard seltzer (plus domestic beer) to all registered participants and guests. After dinner, staff will set up another communal campfire and yard games! (For those looking for a family flick in lieu of our party playlist, the KOA plans to show *The Goonies* on Saturday Evening up by the bike shed.)

KOA quiet hours begin promptly at 11:00pm. Our parties will officially end, and the music will stop in accordance with this regulation on both nights, but that does not mean your fun has to end. Feel free to hang out with your friends both old and new back at your campsites until you've had all the fun that you can handle. (Just don't wake up your neighbors.)
